

## Quadra Island NEPP Wildfire Preparedness Activities

Encourage neighbours to sign up for ALERTABLE notifications: <a href="https://srd.ca/alerts">https://srd.ca/alerts</a>
Encourage neighbours to FireSmart their properties and adhere to published fire bans.
Provide neighbours with a copy of the Emergency Preparedness Workbook, and encourage them to have:
<ul> <li>A personal plan for evacuation</li> <li>A plan for their pets</li> <li>"Grab &amp; Go" bags for each family member, and pet(s).</li> </ul>
Identify primary and alternate evacuation routes out of your neighbourhood, and make these known to residents. An alternate route may have to be to shoreline for a water evacuation in the event roads are blocked or threatened.
Create and maintain a phone tree for your neighbourhood.
Identity residents who may need help in evacuating:
<ul> <li>Mobility issues</li> <li>Transportation</li> <li>Children at home while parent(s) at work.</li> </ul>
Know who in your neighbourhood is away for extended periods during fire season (so responders do not spend time trying to locate them during evacuation).
Be prepared yourself to evacuate if necessary. If you are prepared, you will be better able to help others.
